#### Monday the 29<sup>th</sup> of April

If you have not got enough of the Norwegian air and the scenery of Bodø, you are welcome to stay longer at your own discretion. We recommend to use this day as travel day as well, however there might be a small morning rush in the morning, we advise that to be taken into account.

#### **Practical information**

There will soon become available an online sign-up form. It is important that we know if you attend our conference and other details regarding your stay in Bodø. You will get notified when the form is up, but we recommend to check the website of UNOF [https://orkester.no/] as there will be published an update there as well.

The conference will last from and including the 26<sup>th</sup> of April 2024 until the 28<sup>th</sup> of April 2024. There is of course a possibility to extend your stay before and/or after, however that will not be included in the participation fee. Nevertheless, we can assist if you want to stay at the conference hotel for one night at either end. More information will be provided.

Bodø Airport is an international airport very close to the city center (airport code BOO), however it is not of the largest size and there are some limitations regarding arrival and departure options. We recommend that you already now search for travel routes and; please take a small note that the weather may not be on your side. The local concert venue is called "Stormen" which literally translates into "The Storm".
